TECH TIPS

We had the Safe-T-Plus Steering Control put on our RV a few years ago at the Perry rally. Bought it as insurance, hoping we would never need it. Coming back from Fla. the end of April this year our front right tire blew on I-75 around Venice, Fl. We were in the right lane and with fuel costs so high, Ken was keeping it down around 60-65. From the horrendous noise, we knew a tire had blown, but the steering control worked so good, Ken wasn't sure which tire until he pulled off and got out and looked! He couldn't feel any tug in the wheel at all and easily steered off the road. We've heard some horror stories from people without this aid and now we know how terrific it is. We highly recommend the product.
