Father Christmas is always a highlight of our Christmas outings.




Father Christmas (Fred Tomsett) distributed gifts to everyone

Roy Sowers (Metros) takes Fred Tomsett's mess kit from him.




Betty Werner chose a bottle of merlot, but she didn't get to keep it.




