Recipe for Chocolate Eclair Cake

1 box graham crackers 2 pks French vanilla instant pudding mix

3-1/2 cups milk

9 oz. Cool Whip

Frosting:

- 2 squares unsweetened chocolate
- 1-1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 3 Tablespoons butter
- 3 Tablespoons milk
- 2 Tablespoons vanilla

Butter pan and line with graham crackers. Mix pudding, milk, and Cool Whip. Pour over crackers in pan and top with another layer of graham crackers.

For the frosting, melt chocolate & butter. Add syrup, milk, vanilla & sugar. Mix & spread over top. Let set 24 hours.


