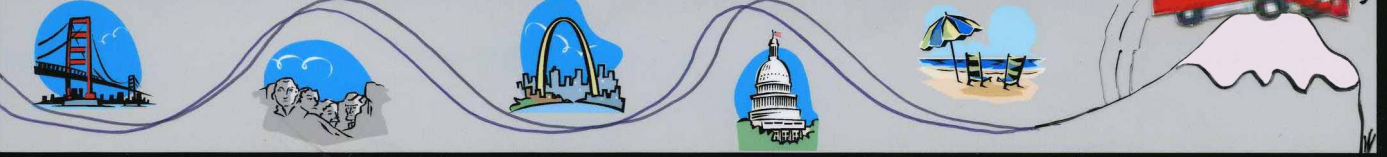

And don't forget your Super Hero or Villain costume.

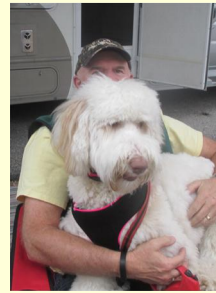

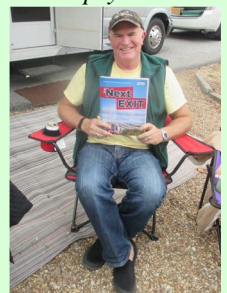

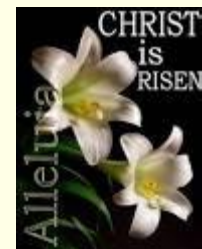
